

Automatic transmission:


- P = park
- R = reverse
- N = neutral D = drive

The selector lever can only be moved out of **P** or **N** when the ignition is on and the foot brake is depressed (selector lever lock).

To engage P or R, press the release button on selector lever.

Manual transmission:

Reverse aear: With vehicle stationary, wait 3 seconds after depressing clutch pedal, then press button on selector lever and engage gear.




Opening the load compartment: To open the tailgate, press the button under the moulding after unlocking the vehicle.

Warnina:

Do not drive with the tailgate open or ajar, e.g. when transporting bulky objects, as toxic exhaust gases could enter the vehicle.

Closing the load compartment: Use the interior handle to close the tailgate.

Do not press the button under the tailaate mouldina while closina, as this will unlock the tailgate again.



Lift the safety catch upwards and open the bonnet.

Vehicle features

Engine oil:

Check the engine oil level manually on a regular basis to prevent damage to the engine. Ensure that the correct specification of oil is used. Check with the vehicle on a level surface. The engine must be at operating temperature and switched off for at least 5 minutes.

Pull out the dipstick, wipe it clean, insert it to the stop on the handle, pull out and read the engine oil level. Insert dipstick to stop on handle and make half a turn. When the engine oil level has dropped to the **MIN** mark, top-up engine oil.

Important:

It is the owner's responsibility to maintain the correct level of an appropriate auality oil in the engine. Do not allow the engine oil level to drop below the minimum level!

Tyre pressure:

Check tyre pressures, including the spare, every 14 days and prior to any long journey; tyres should be checked when cold. This also applies to vehicles with tyre pressure monitoring system.

Remove the valve cap key from the fuel filler flap and use it to unscrew the valve cap. On vehicles with tyre pressure monitoring system, screw the adapter to the valve.

The tyre pressure data refers to cold tyres. It applies to summer and winter tyres.

Always inflate the spare tyre to the value specified for full load.

The driver is responsible for correct adjustment of tyre pressure.

Warning:

If the pressure is too low, this can result in considerable tyre warm-up and internal damage, leading to tread separation and even to tyre blow-out at high speeds.


To open, turn cap slowly to the left. E DIN 51626-1 or equivalent.

Diesel engines - use diesel fuel meeting specifications of EN 590.

Before refuelling, switch off engine bracket on the filler flap.

To refuel, fully insert the pump nozzle and switch it on. After the automatic cut-off, the tank can be topped-up with maximum two doses of fuel.

Wipe off any overflowing fuel immediately.



Locking the vehicle:

Press button = on remote control - or - turn key in driver's door lock to lock vehicle and activate anti-theft alarm system.

Operate twice within 15 seconds to deadlock all doors

Open&Start system:

Touch the sensor field in the door handle of one of the front doors. Touch the sensor field twice within 15 seconds to deadlock all doors.

Electronic immobiliser:

Activated automatically when key is removed from ignition switch or when engine is switched off by pressing the Start/Stop button.

Vehicle features

Longitudinal seat adjustments Pull handle, slide seat, release handle.

Danger:

Do not sit nearer than 25 cm from the steering wheel, to permit safe airbag deployment.



Lumbar support Turn handwheel. Do not lean on backrest when adjusting.

Seat belt: Withdraw seat belt from retractor. 1. Pull belt out slightly. guide it untwisted across the body 2. Press button. and insert latch plate in belt buckle. 3. Adjust height and engage.

To release belt, press red button on Adjust height so that belt lies belt buckle.



Seat backrests: Turn handwheel. Do not lean on seat when adjusting.

Head restraint adjustment: Press the release button, adjust height and engage.

Interior mirror: To reduce dazzle, swivel the lever on the underside of the mirror housina.



Automatic anti-dazzle interior mirror

Dazzle from following vehicles at night is automatically reduced if the vehicle is equipped with an automatic anti-dazzle interior mirror.

The lever will not be present on the underside of the mirror housing.



Electrical folding mirrors:

Press the button to fold exterior Power windows can be operated mirrors. Press again to return them with the ignition on and within to their original position.

If an electrically folded mirror is manually extended, pressing button 🖼 will only electrically extend the other mirror.

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Manual foldina mirrors: The exterior mirrors can be folded in by pressing gently on the outer edge of the housing.

For pedestrian safety, the exterior mirrors will swing out of their normal mounting position if they

are struck with sufficient force. Reposition the mirror by applying slight pressure to the mirror

housina.



Power windows:

windows: 5 minutes of switching ignition off, deactivate the switches in the rear unless driver's door is opened. doors.

Operate the switch for the respective window by pushing to open or pulling to close.

For vehicles with automatic feature, pull or press the switch again to stop window movement. Safety function:

If the window alass encounters resistance above the middle of the window during automatic closing, it is immediately stopped and opened again.

Overload:

If the windows are operated repeatedly at short intervals, window operation is temporarily disabled.



Electrical exterior mirrors: Select the relevant exterior mirror with the switch, then swivel the control to adjust the mirror.





Turn light switch: AUTO = Automatic light control: Headliahts are switched on and off automatically external light conditions are poor.



Windscreen wiper:

- = = Fast
- = Slow
- -- = Timed interval wiping or automatic wiping with rain sensor

For a single wipe when the windscreen wiper is off, press the lever down.

Run through the windscreen wiper stages by pushing the lever past the resistance point and holding. An acoustic signal sounds at **O**.

Do not use if the windscreen is frozen.

Switch off in car washes.



Windscreen and headlight washer:

Pull lever. Washer fluid is sprayed onto the windscreen and the wiper mode. Switch off by pushing lever wipes for a few strokes.

If the headlights are on, washer fluid is also sprayed onto the headlights. The headlight washer system is then inoperable for 2 minutes.



Rear window wiper and washer: Push lever forwards. The rear

window wiper swipes in interval forwards again.

If the lever is held forwards, washer fluid is sprayed onto the rear window.

Do not use if the rear window is frozen

Switch off in car washes.

The rear window wiper comes on automatically when the windscreen wiper is switched on and reverse gear is engaged.



Hazard warning flashers: Operated with the \triangle button. The hazard warning flashers activate automatically if the airbags deploy.



Heated rear window, heated exterior mirrors: The heating is operated by

pressing the 💷 button. Heating functions with the engine running and is switched off

automatically after a short time. Depending on engine type, heating

comes on automatically during driving when the diesel particle filter is being cleaned.



Demisting and defrosting the windows:

- Set air distribution to ³
- Set temperature control to the warmest level.
- Set fan speed to the highest level or to A.
- Switch cooling 🗘 on.
- Press button W.
- Switch heated rear window III
- Open side air vents and direct them towards the door windows.
- For simultaneous warming of the foot well, set air distribution to position 🖼.
