Using Smartphone tethering

If your vehicle is not equipped with a Connect Box, you may still be able to benefit from the Live Navigation feature. To do so, you will need to tether your smartphone to your car using it as a Wi-Fi hotspot as detailed below, as well as activating the Live Navigation service in the Vauxhall Connect site.

Start your vehicle and wait until the infotainment system is fully activated - this may take a few seconds.
